### Notice of 185%-200% Federal Poverty Level

You are receiving this notice because you recently enrolled in/recertified for subsidized child care or reported a change in income to your Client Services Counselor.

Based on the income information you provided, it has been determined that your gross household income falls in the 185%-200% Federal Poverty Level range. The Early Learning Coalition of the Nature Coast serves families with income less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Your gross household income is approaching the upper end of the Federal Poverty Level scale. If your household income increases in the near future it is possible that you will become ineligible for the subsidized child care program under which your services are currently funded. If your income exceeds 200% FPL will no longer be eligible and be required to pay your child care costs at the full rates charged by your provider.

Please also be aware that under the Terms and Conditions of the School Readiness Program, which you signed at enrollment/recertification, you are required to notify the Coalition of any changes in your income no later than 10 days after the change occurs and would be liable for prosecution for Public Assistance Fraud if you fail to report.
