Credible Witness Affidavit (Two Witnesses Personally Known to the Signer and Identity Sufficiently Proven to the Notary)

The witness or witnesses must also swear or affirm before the Notary that the signer named in the document has no identification and is unable to obtain any, and that the witness is not a party to and has no interest in the transaction.

Be certain to attach the credible witness affidavit securely to the document being executed to prove your method of identification of the signer.

When you use this form of identification, place the witness under oath as follows:

Credible Witness Oath

"Do you swear, under penalties of perjury, to the following:

- that you personally know this person as (name of person whose signature is to be notarized);
- that he/she is the person named in the document requiring notarization;
- that it is your reasonable belief that this person does not possess any identification required for a notarization;
- that it is your reasonable belief that it would be difficult or impossible for this person to obtain such identification; and
- that you are not a party to have no interest whatsoever in the transaction taking place, so help you God?"
