Subject: Rilya Wilson Reporting

The Coalition has received information from the Partnership for Strong Families that many providers, Coalition wide, with Rilya Wilson reporting responsibilities have been utilizing ELCNC-222 Rilya Wilson Act Child Absence Reporting Form to report child absences. Please note that the intended destination for Form ELCNC-222 is the Partnership for Strong Families only (Dixie, Gilchrist and Levy Counties). If providers in Citrus and Sumter Counties have Rilya Wilson Absences to report, ELCNC-205 Rilya Wilson Act Child Absence Reporting Form (Citrus and Sumter Counties) should be utilized, destination CPI Supervisor/Sumter County.

ELCNC-204 Rilya Wilson Act Frequently Asked Questions has been amended to provide additional clarification on Rilya Wilson reporting destinations. All three forms referenced in this Provider Alert are attached and also available on the Coalition's website @ www.elc-naturecoast.org.
